Job Description:

91 Place exists to be a safe place for homeless youth to be, grow, and transform. 91 Place offers each resident housing and programming to prepare them for independent living. Support services focus on mental health & therapy, trauma-informed care, education, employment, self-sufficiency, and community. Our hope is that the youth experiencing homelessness exit our home knowing they are loved and capable and never enter back into homelessness. 91 Place is expanding services to include innovative therapy methods and reversing generational poverty and chronic homelessness by creating opportunities for advancing racial and economic justice.

The essential functions of this role are to provide individual and/or group psychotherapy as frequently as determined by the therapist, provide assessments and recommendations, and collaborate with other providers in the client's life. All services are provided in accordance with professional ethics and boundaries.

This position is a vital component of our programming and serves the overall goal of diverting youth out of generational poverty and homelessness by creating a community of individuals of all ages who are able to identify and address the traumas and mental illnesses that so often contribute to long-term oppression.

Objectives of this Role:

- Complete a bio-psycho-social assessment of the client and develop a plan of treatment with the client based on your therapeutic recommendations
- Administer therapeutic treatment interventions, including but not limited to: stress management, symptom reduction, and life skills therapy to assist clients, and group therapy.
- Refer clients for appropriate services when necessary
- Change method and degree of therapy when indicated by clients' needs
- Responsible for completing case notes and treatment plans, via a secure HIPPA Compliant platform



- Maintain regular contact with external community providers concerning coordination of care, as required, through phone calls, emails, face-to-face meetings etc.
