## **91 Place Opens New Emergency Shelter for Young Adults in Indianapolis: Ase's Place**

**Indianapolis, IN** – Young adults experiencing homelessness in Indianapolis now have a new resource. *Ase's Place* will provide emergency housing for up to nine individuals ages 18–24 and is only the second emergency intake shelter in the city dedicated to this population.

Named after a former client, *Ase's Place* is designed to be a safe and supportive environment for young people facing housing instability. The program provides not only immediate shelter but also supportive services including case management, education and employment resources, and pathways to more permanent housing.

"Young people in crisis deserve a place where they can feel safe, respected, and supported," said CEO Ali Cross. "Ase's Place will provide immediate stability at a critical moment and help young adults take their next steps toward independence."

The opening reflects 91 Place's deepening commitment to addressing youth homelessness. This facility stands as only the second emergency intake shelter in Indianapolis; the organization strengthens the community's ability to respond quickly to urgent housing needs.

"We're not just here to give a bed for the night, we're here to help young people build something real for their future," said Director of Housing Michael Anderson. "Ase's Place is one more way we're showing up to help young people fight against homelessness."

**Program Note:** In addition to emergency housing, 91 Place offers *whole-life programming* through its Phase Two and Phase Three protocols. These phases provide structured pathways toward independence—helping residents build life skills, pursue education and employment, strengthen relationships, and establish stability in permanent housing.
