91 Place provides transitional housing and wraparound support for young adults ages 18–24 experiencing homelessness in Indianapolis. Residents live with us for up to two years in our transitional living home, where they build the skills, stability, and confidence to sustain independent lives. Our model is grounded in SAMHSA’s 8 Dimensions of Wellness, and mental health support is central to everything we do.

We are seeking a licensed therapist to join our team on a contract basis, providing individual and group therapy services directly at our transitional living home.

The Role

This is a contract, part-time position. Hours are variable and will adjust based on the number of residents currently in the program — up to a maximum of 8 residents at any given time. Services are delivered on-site at our transitional living home in Indianapolis.

- **Individual Therapy:** Provide 1:1 private therapy sessions for residents enrolled in the Transitional Living Program (TLP). Sessions will be scheduled in coordination with program staff.
- **Group Therapy:** Facilitate regular group therapy sessions for residents. Topics may include trauma processing, emotional regulation, life transitions, and building healthy relationships.
- **Documentation:** Maintain accurate, timely clinical notes and records in compliance with applicable licensing and program requirements.
- **Collaboration:** Work closely with 91 Place program staff to support resident care plans and flag clinical concerns as appropriate.

Required Qualifications

- Active licensure as an LCSW, LMHC, or LMFT in the state of Indiana
- Demonstrated experience working with trauma-affected populations
- Experience providing therapy to young adults (ages 18–24) or in a youth-serving setting
- Trauma-informed care training or equivalent clinical experience
- Ability to work independently in a residential setting with limited on-site supervision
- Strong clinical judgment and ability to identify and escalate risk appropriately

Preferred Qualifications

- Experience with housing-instability, homelessness, or crisis populations
- Familiarity with SAMHSA’s 8 Dimensions of Wellness framework
- Group therapy facilitation experience
- Biosound therapy certification or openness to training (we are one of only three providers in Indiana using this modality)
